## **Beaver/Leland/Kendall Intersection Improvements**

### **PROJECT OVERVIEW**

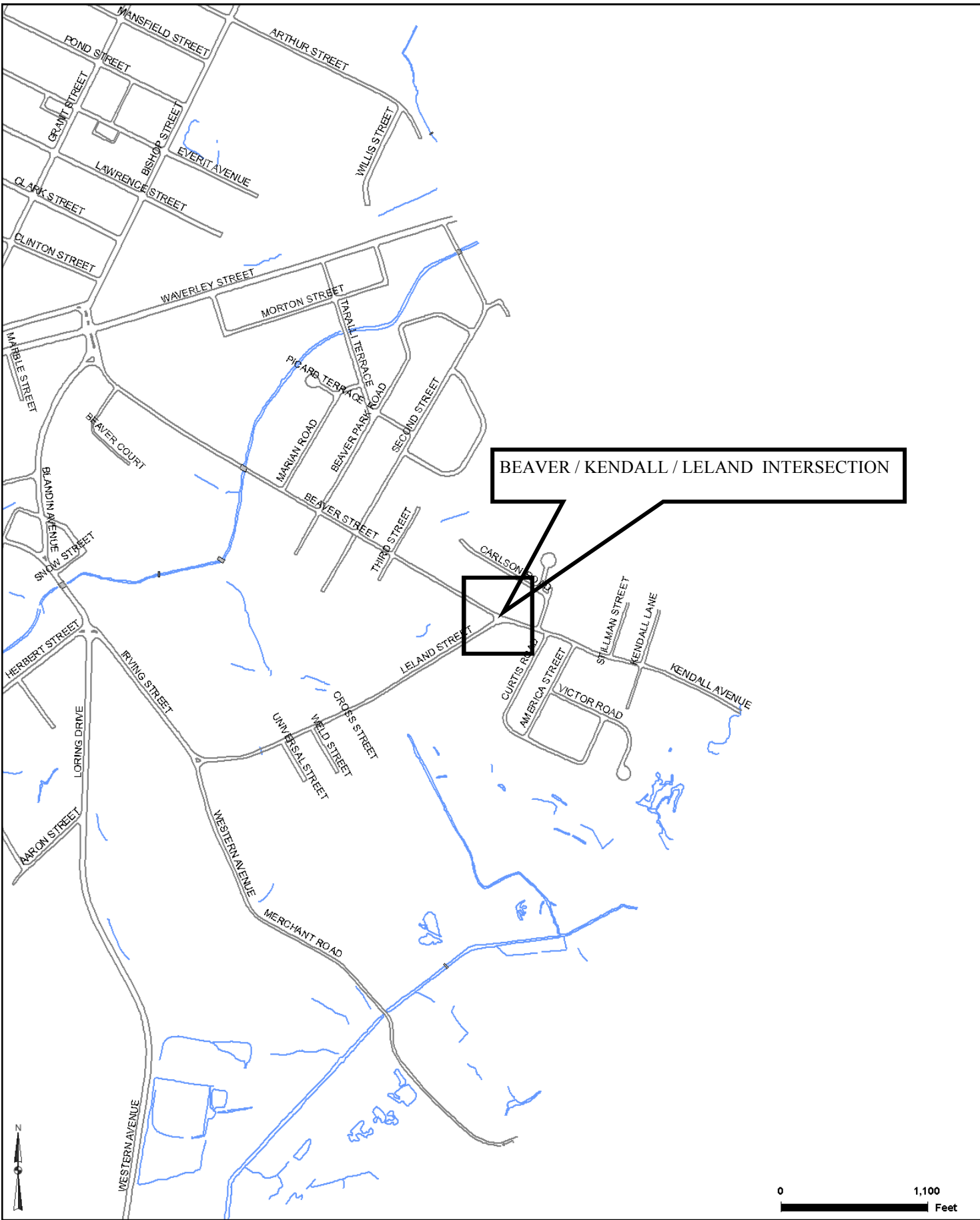
The project will address safety concerns at this intersection and will consist of adjusting the curb-line along the northeast corner of Leland Street where it intersects with Kendall Avenue. The bumped out curb-line will tighten the intersection to provide the desired result to slow down and deter vehicles from taking these turning movements at a high rate of speed and a gradual angle. Also along Leland Street, three new scored concrete islands will be constructed to help better define the travel lanes at the intersection. New ADA-compliant wheelchair ramps and appropriate crosswalk striping and signage will also be constructed as part of the project.

### **PROJECT SCHEDULE**

Construction will begin and be completed this summer.
